North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Limited <u>Meritorious Scholarships Scheme</u>

INTRODUCTION:

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Limited Scholarships Scheme is being formulated to extend financial Assistance to the project affected and local needy students and children of NEEPCO Employees to promote and encourage higher education. NEEPCO Scholarships are designed to cater to the needs of student in a wide variety of areas ranging from 10½/ ITI, Engineering to MBBS and other Degree Courses. All scholarships are being provided strictly on merit-cum-need basis, with special encouragement to girl students, physically challenged students, and students from North East States.

II SCOPE:

- The Scholarships are offered to eligible students pursuing the following full time courses in Schools / Colleges /Institutions /Universities recognized by ICSE /CBSE / ISC / State Education Boards/ MCI / AICTE/ Association of Indian Universities:
 - i. 10+ / Diploma course from ITIs.
 - ii. B.Sc / B.Com. / B.A.etc.
 - iii. B.E. / B.Tech.
 - iv. MBBS
- 2. The Scholarship will be given to economically backward students living within 10 km radius of NEEPCO's Operating Stations and Projects under Execution and who otherwise fulfill the eligibility requirements.

3. The Scholarship will also be given to the children of NEEPCO Employees who secured minimum 90% marks in their 10th and 12th standard examination or equivalent.

III. ELIGIBILITY:

FOR ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD STUDENT (LOCAL & PROJECT AFFECTED) WHO LIVE WITHIN 10 KM RADIUS OF NEEPCO'S OPERATING STATIONS AND PROJECTS UNDER EXECUTION.

The minimum eligibility criteria for application is listed below:

- For 10+/ITI/Diploma scholarships, students securing a minimum of 65% marks in their 10th and 12th standard examination or equivalent may apply.
- For Degree Courses, students securing a minimum of 65% marks in their 12th
 Standard examination or equivalent and having a confirmed admission into a full
 time degree course may apply.
- For Engineering Scholarships, students securing a minimum of 65% marks in their 12th standard examination or equivalent and having confirmed admission into a full time engineering degree course may apply.
- For MBBS Scholarships, students securing a minimum of 65% marks in their 12th standard examination or equivalent and having confirmed admission into a full time MBBS degree course may apply.
- In all cases, the gross joint income of the family of the candidate from all sources should not exceed Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) per annum.
- Scholarship will be awarded to one student in a family.
- The minimum and maximum age limits are 15 years and 25 years respectively.
- The student should not avail any other scholarship facilities from any institute
 / Govt



FOR THE CHILDREN OF NEEPCO EMPLOYEES:

- 90% marks in 10th Standard for Course in Para II (1) (i) and 90% marks in 12th
 Standard for Courses under Para II (1) (ii), (iii) and (iv).
- The student should not avail any other scholarship facilities from any institute / Govt.
 - The minimum and maximum age limits are 15 years and 25 years respectively.

V. METHOD FOR SELECTION:

- 2(Two) students for each of the Courses mentioned in Para II (1) shall be selected out of students living within 10 km radius of each of Operating Stations and Projects under Execution and who have applied for the scholarship and otherwise fulfill the eligibility requirements.
- Scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of percentage of marks secured in 10th Standard for Course in Para II (1) (i) and 12th Standard for Courses under Para II (1) (ii), (iii) and (iv).
 - 5 (five) percentage Bonus marks shall be added in case of Physically Handicapped applicants for selection for award of the Scholarship
 - 3 (three) percentage Bonus marks shall be added in case of female applicants for selection for award of the Scholarship
- All Children of NEEPCO employees who fulfill the eligibility criteria shall be awarded the scholarship

VI. Amount of NEEPCO Meritorious Scholarship

The scholarship shall be paid annually for the minimum duration of the course at the following rates. Through the Head of Institution/College.

• 10+ /Diploma course from ITIs

@ Rs.12,000/- per annum.

B.Sc / B.Com / B.A. etc.

@ Rs. 12,000/- per annum.

• B.E./ B.Tech.

@ Rs.36,000/- per annum.

· MBBS

@ Rs.36,000/- per annum.

VI. PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

FOR ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD STUDENT (LOCAL & PROJECT AFFECTED)
WHO LIVE WITHIN 10 KM RADIUS OF NEEPCO'S OPERATING STATIONS
AND PROJECTS UNDER EXECUTION.

- i) The application should accompany:
 - a) One copy of the application for the scholarship in the prescribed form.
 - b) One copy of a recent passport size photograph with signature to be pasted on the application form in the space provided)
 - c) Attested copy of the certificates, mark sheet, pass certificate in respect of the last examination passed, (Original documents should not be sent unless called for). NEEPCO will not be responsible for loss of original documents, if send without calling for.
 - d) An income proof certificate from District Authority.
 - e): Proof of permanent residence from District Authority
 - ii) Candidate should ensure that they apply through the Deputy Commissioner and with the recommendation of the Head of the Project of their respective area.
